No dairy cattle will be admitted to the grounds unless thoroughly tractable. In all Dairy classes in which age is a condition of Competition, the Entry Form shall state the actual day of birth (day, month and year). Age for classification will be that of the animal on 1st April 2017. Registration Certificates to be available. All cattle entered in the Ground Milking Classes, Group Classes and Schools or Non-Commercial Breeder competition must be entered and shown in the General cases. The society will not be responsible for any accident caused through or by an Exhibitor or person and will not under any circumstances hold itself responsible for any loss or misdelivery of livestock of any kind, or for damage done thereto. The cattle Section of the Grand Parade will be held at approximately 2.00pm Saturday, 17th June and all livestock exhibitors are requested to parade their ribboned Exhibits. TWICE A DAY MILKING Cattle are to be on the grounds by 4.30pm Thursday, 15th June. (a) Details of entries to be in the hands of the Secretary at least 6 days prior to strip out. (b) Details required - Animal's name, date of birth, tattoo or identification, breed and date of calving. (c) Test to be by method approved by D.P.I. (d) The Official Strip Out will take place at 6.00pm on Thursday 15th June. Milking for the competition to be at 6.00am and 6.00pm Friday, 16th June. (e) Each cow is to be milked for not more than 20 minutes. A milker is allowed to milk only 5 animals. (f) Each cow will be allotted a milking order or division and is to be milked in that order throughout the competition. (g) No lactation points allowed. (h) Any cow that is supplied with milk or animal fat other than supplied in recognised protein meat as food during the tests shall be disqualified, together with the Exhibitor. The administration of medication to be done only under Veterinary Supervision. (i) To be eligible to compete cows must have calved at least 7 (seven) days prior to strip out. BEEF REGULATIONS Exhibitors please note the following Conditions apply to ALL classes. The Sunshine Coast Show Society Inc adopts the QCAS rules as part of their rules. These rules are the rules of our show. ALL SHOW CATTLE MUST BE TICK FREE TO ENTER THE SHOWGROUNDS. All exhibits must be on the Showgrounds no later than 8.00 pm Thursday, 9th June. Please enter by the Bli Bli Roads Gates only. All cattle to be unloaded at ramps as directed by Stewards. All vehicles are to be parked at Crushers Grounds (monitored by security). Exit is by Crushers Grounds only. No stud beef cattle will be admitted to the grounds unless thoroughly tractable. All cattle must be bona fide property of the Exhibitor for three (3) mths prior to the Show. All ribboned exhibits must be led in the Grand Parade. Failure to do so may lead to disqualification. Whilst all reasonable care is taken, the Society cannot accept any responsibility for any losses of, or damage or injury to or by, any livestock, exhibits, equipment, vehicles or any other property. All exhibitors who participate in the show ring MUST wear dust jackets or Society approved uniform at all times when their animal is presented to the judge. Any exhibitors/competitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with residual current protection and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected by a licensed electrical contractor and currently tagged. The use of double adaptors is prohibited and all power boards must be tested and tagged. No dispute will be considered whilst the event is in progress. Protest to be lodged in writing within thirty minutes after the Class in dispute is completed and must be handed to the Show Secretary accompanied by a fee of \$50. The dispute committee will consist of three management committee and their decision will be final. It is forbidden to administer any prohibited drug or cause one to be administered in any way whatsoever. A prohibited drug means any substance originating externally to the animal (whether or not endogenous to the animal) capable of affecting the performance or behaviour of any animal by its action upon central or peripheral nervous system, the cardiovascular system, the respiratory system, the alimentary system, the musculo-skeletal system or the uro-genital system and shall include analgesics, anti-histamines, anti-inflammatory agents, blood coagulants, diuretics, hormones and their synthetic counterparts, cortico-steroids, anabolic steroids, local anaesthetics, muscle relaxants and tranquillizers Any exhibit which has been brought to the Showgrounds and is found to have had administered to it any prohibited drug as defined above may, without prejudice to any other action which may be taken in respect of the matter, be debarred by the Show Stewards from competing in any event for which it may have been entered. No drug, hormone or tranquillizer shall be administered to any animal exhibit except under the direction of the Society's Veterinary Surgeon who will advise the Stewards if in his opinion such drug, hormone or tranquillizer is likely to have any effect upon the animal which would be material to its chances of being award a prize and in such case the Stewards may debar the animal from competing. In Prime Cattle, growth promotion substance is permitted. A Show Steward may at any time direct the Society's Veterinary Surgeon to take a sample of blood, saliva or urine from an exhibit for testing. Any testing carried out is defiantly at the expense of the exhibitor or owner of exhibit.
